

# Passionate Tigers

**DISPELLING** memories of their recent indifferent home form, Hyde turned in a determined and passionate display, on Saturday, resulting in a deserved late equaliser from leading scorer David Nolan.

The Tigers had started brightly on a bumpy Nethermoor surface, with Ged Kimmins firing into the side netting after breaking clear on the right.

Shortly after, latching on to a long clearance, Paul Varden spotted keeper Dickinson off his line, but his attempted lob sailed narrowly over.

Hyde were dominating possession, with Val Owen and man of the match Colin Lambert powerhouses in midfield.

On 30 minutes, Jason Gallagher fed Kimmins, who beat ex-England international Hogarth for pace, and crossed for Lutel James to drive wide.

More chances followed, with Lambert rising high to head over. However, as the half drew to a close, the Tigers Hyde survived a late scare when Kimmins had to turn defender to clear off the line.

Guiseley enjoyed their best spell of the game at the start of the second half, with Lee Elam blasting over following a poor punch by Jon Scargill.

On 55 minutes, the home side took the lead when manager

Bobby Davison drove a speculative shot over the stranded Scargill.

Two minutes later, the Yorkshiremen could have increased their advantage when Davison forced a scrambling save from Scargill.

Hyde were not to be fazed, however, and began to reassert their first-half authority.

Dickinson dealt easily with a Varden free kick, and then had to save bravely at the feet of Kimmins. He was helpless, however, when a stinging effort from James grazed the post.

Just when time was running out, the Tigers grabbed an equaliser when a Kimmins cross was headed powerfully down by Lambert, for Nolan to rifle home.

Right at the death, Hyde could have won. In a surging run, Owen broke five attempted tackles before Dickinson stopped him with another superb save.
